

## CALL FOR PAPERS

The IARPP 11<sup>th</sup> International Annual Conference

### **“Meeting of Traditions: Field, Link and Matrix in Psychoanalytic Theory and Practice”**

will be held in Santiago de Chile from Thursday, November 7th through Sunday, November 10th, 2013. The main aim of this conference is to emphasize a comparative approach and to explore the convergences and divergences between the theoretical and clinical developments on the Relational and Latin American traditions that have both made use of the concepts of Field, Matrix and Link. The Conference will be bilingual, English and Spanish.

We welcome all interested professionals to submit individual papers and/or panel proposals. Panels should include no more than three papers (or just two and a discussant) related to the several topics that will be addressed at the Conference (\*); panel sessions are scheduled for 90 minutes total. Individually submitted papers must be no longer than 20 minutes in presentation to be considered by the selection committee. Panel speakers will each have 15-20 minutes for their presentation. Individual papers that are accepted for presentation may be grouped with other papers in any session.

#### Submission Process:

1. For Papers and Panel submission an anonymous abstract no less than 500 words and no longer than 700 must be send, either in English or Spanish, to both Co-chairs, and in a separated attachment a brief Curriculum Vitae of no more than 200 words and the call for papers cover sheet (electronic version available at <http://www.iarpp2013.cl>).

2. The deadline for the reception of these abstracts is January 13, 2013
3. The abstracts will be evaluated by the scientific committee that will respond by March 3, 2013 if an abstract has been accepted or not.
4. If your proposal is accepted, the final and complete paper must be submitted before June 30, 2013.
5. The final version should be no longer than **10 pages A4**, double-spaced, with Arial font to be no smaller than 12 point, with 1 ¼ inch margins on all four sides (approximately 2,500 words).

6. Considering that this is the first IARPP international bi-lingual conference, the program and scientific committee would appreciate the authors to provide a corresponding English or Spanish translation of the final version of the papers.
