CALL FOR PAPERS*

The IARPP Annual Conference, "*Expanding the Relational Context: Desire, Sexuality, Politics, Economics, Aesthetics, Technologies*" will be held in San Francisco, California from Thursday, February 25 through Sunday, February 28, 2010. The conference will forge a dialogue between relational psychoanalysts and colleagues working in other intellectual fields and socio-cultural domains in order to broaden the horizon of our theory and clinical work. We will explore how the relational contexts wherein people live and form the experience of self and other is rapidly changing given expanding sexual frontiers, advances in technology, and recent global economic and political crises.

We welcome all IARPP Members to submit paper and/or panel proposals that address these themes. The conference will feature plenary panels, paper presentations, and interdisciplinary conversations with an emphasis on clinical and social intervention. Audience participation and discussion will be encouraged by a format that calls for short papers followed by conversations with interlocutors and audience members rather than formal discussants.

Individual papers and panel presentations are welcome. Paper sessions are scheduled for one hour and a half, including 20-30-minute paper presentations and 15-minute responses from interlocutors, who may be from other disciplines, followed by audience discussion. Papers must be no longer than 30 minutes in presentation. Interlocutors will be assigned to paper sessions, however submissions of papers that are paired as a panel may suggest an interlocutor on the Cover Sheet.

*** Paper and/or Panel Submission Process ***

The **deadline for receipt of papers and/or panels is Monday, June 15, 2009**. <u>No names should appear on</u> <u>your abstract</u> as reviews of submissions are anonymous. You must submit your presentation as an email attachment sent to <u>nilou@km-direct.com</u>. *ONLY IARPP MEMBERS MAY MAKE A SUBMISSION*. Please be sure to include the title of your paper and, when it is paired with another paper, the title of your panel on the page with a detailed, one paragraph Abstract and 2 Educational Objectives.

Please submit the following materials:

- 1. Call for Papers **Cover Sheet** (electronic version available at <u>www.iarpp.org</u>)
- 2. One paragraph **Abstract** and 2 **Educational Objectives** for your presentation ("At the conclusion of my presentation, the participant will be able to: (describe, explain, illustrate...)" *These items should be on the same page and must be typed.*)
- 3. Brief **Curriculum Vitae** (no more than 2 pages)

Due to accreditation application requirements, all of these materials must be submitted in order for your submission to be reviewed. We regret that presentations submitted *without* all of the above items *cannot be considered* for review. All submissions will be reviewed by the Program Committee. Authors will be notified of the Committee's decision by **August 2009**. Acceptance is limited by space availability.
